You will need two websites for sports graphics.

WEBSITE 1: Sports Graphics Maker/Updater

- a. Where you can make graphics
- b. Where you will update scores

1. Sign in


2. Select the Roses 2024 League




3. Find your event and press input scores

- b. E.g. Netball- Women's 1st (events will be in the order of the weekend)




4. Changing Graphics- Starting Timers and Goals



Pressing Goal will bring up this box where you can say which team have scored (don't worry about adding a player)

5. Declaring a Winner


a. When the game finishes click the declare winner button which brings up this box below where you can pick which team won.

- The page will look different for different sports as all sports are timed and scored differently

E.g. Basketball- different numbers of points




WEBSITE 2: Sports Graphics Controller

- a. This is used to show or hide the graphics on the stream
- b. A key from this will need to be put into the streaming software (your tech lead will do this but you may need to remind them)
- c. The website for this will depend what OB Kit you are using



1. Click Sports-Graphics-Controller in the top left



- 2. Click Select Event
 - a. League: Roses 2024
 - b. Then find your event and confirm
- 3. Control which graphics get seen on stream
 - a. Status says whether the graphic is live
 - b. LIVE brings it on to the stream
 - c. KILL removes it from the stream

NOTE: you must have the scoreboard LIVE to make the clock LIVE



Use the Match Status Popup for in between quarters/halves and at the end of the game to display a big lower third with the scores
