Producers are in charge of coordinating the sports streams and ensuring that all crew, technical team, computing team, commentators / presenters, studio crew and sports teams are on the same page.

We will be streaming all our sports coverage to roseslive.co.uk.

FAQ

Key Contacts to Have:

A short description of your duties and responsibilities before and during the weekend:

- 1. Creating a slack channel and making crew aware of details and updates for your stream
- 2. Contacting sports teams for Team Sheets and information about their sport
- Being present and prepared on the day. Ensure that the quality of your broadcast is as high as possible.
- 4. Keeping Graphics up to date (TV Only)
- 5. Grabbing people for interviews from both teams after the game finishes

Make sure to tick off each step in the Producer Checklist Spreadsheet as you do it

Step 1: Get on Slack:

We use the Slack app to communicate about absolutely everything

- 1. First of all, make sure you're in the Roses Media Slack workspace (if you've already used it for YSTV/URY, note that this is a different one - though you still use the same app to access it). If not, click this link:

- 2. Join #2024-producers for general updates.

Step 2: Contact your equivalent producer and create a channel:

- 1. Most streams have a RADIO and TV Producer so get in contact with your equivalent producer either through your streams channel or DMs
- 2. Decide between you who is contacting the sports teams (you dont both need to do this but CC each other)
- 3. Make a joint TV and Radio channel for the streams you're producing (find the "Add channels" button, then click "Create Channel"). Please name it #2024-<day>-<sport> (e.g. #2024-saturday-rugbyunion).
- 4. If your equivalent producer is not responding let Sam Rooke and Fion Cudmore know
- 5. Check if you have an assistant producer, this will generally be on long streams so you can have a break. Make sure to keep them in the loop with all the details so they can help you out.

Where possible, please have any discussions with your co-producers in your sport's Slack channel (#2024-<day>-<sport>), so that everyone's on the same page and we can help out if needed!

Step 3: Contact the sports club

- 1) Email your sports team on their @yusu.org or @groups.lancaster.ac.uk email to let them know of our plans to stream their sport.

- 2) Also find their sports account on instagram and DM the team the same message

The message should include:

- a) Introducing yourself as the TV or Radio producer
- b) Specifying which **team(s) each producer is producing** (i.e. Women's 1sts) and the **time/location**.
- c) Link this document and ask the sports to fill out the appropriate forms:
 - i) Just make sure that if you're covering multiple matches/games that the teams are informed that they have to fill out separate forms/team sheets for the different teams.

These forms will give you information about the match and the teams for the commentators and for you as a producer to form your broadcast.

You can see the responses <u>here</u> and search for the teams you are covering Upload the completed

Step 4: Contact your crew

- 1) Add your crew to your slack channel (once crewing assignments are complete)
 - a) You can check the crew by opening the <u>"Roses Schedule" app</u> in Slack and clicking "View Full Crew".
 - b) If the sport you're producing has multiple fixtures with different crews, you may find it helpful to make extra channels to avoid wires getting crossed. In this case, please name them #2024-<day>-<sport>-<fixture> (e.g. #2024-saturday-hockey-3rds). If at least 50% of the crew are the same you don't need an extra channel, instead just add them all to the same one.

Contact crew members via email if they're not on Slack yet - and send them the link to join!

If you're having trouble with finding crew members make sure to speak with Beth Marsch or Sarah Maguire for support!

2) Send out a message to your crew via slack and pin it in the chat.

This should be done no more than 3 days before the stream to make sure all crew are correct.

Copy and paste this format below and fill in the sections in square brackets.

Hi @channel,

You're crewing [sport and fixture].

This is taking place at [location and how to get here]

MAP OF LOCATIONS HERE

Please arrive at [arrival time], ready to go live at [broadcast time].

The stream will end at [end time]

If you have any issues related to this production please feel free to message me either here or privately on slack.

If on the day you need to contact me for any reason you can call **[phone number]**. And if you need to speak to the tech lead call **[tech lead number]**.

Any other questions or issues refer to this document for who to contact.

Look forward to seeing you there!

Step 5: On the Day!

- 1) Message your crew on your Slack channel the morning of the stream, reminding them of what time & where to meet you. Also be sure to post your phone number in case anyone's running late! Use @channel just to make sure everyone sees it.
- 2) If this is a TV stream, you'll mainly be Floor Managing, and operating graphics.
 - a) Graphics guide can be found here
- 3) For all streams, you'll also be communicating with the studio livestream (for TV) or Continuity (for radio), telling your commentators to (for example) introduce everyone to the sport if the studio or Continuity will be broadcasting your sport in particular. You will also be finding players for interviews.
- 4) Please drop any major sporting updates into the #moments slack channel (such as goals or half time scores), these can then be read out on the radio stream and also allows the events to be timestamped to make editing easier.
 - a) It also allows our head of highlights Erin McLeod to create showreels and highlights of the broadcast(s) over the course of the weekend.
- 5) Do not hesitate to ask for help if you need any! Everyone (especially, but not only, the people on the list below) is here to help you make your stream the best it can be, so please ask if you're ever unsure.

I'm unsure about what to do?



If you have any confusion about what to do in order to tick off certain areas please check back over this document. Also contact your fellow producer from the other media (TV/Radio)on the same sport if you're having trouble getting in touch with your team or making your spreadsheet. If you are still unsure then....

Where will it be streamed to?

All individual streams alongside the primary stream Radio and TV streams will be streamed to https://roseslive.co.uk. TV will also be available to view on multiple screens around campus on the weekend itself.

I already have Slack but can't see anything about Roses?

We're using a different Slack Workspace from the typical YSTV/URY one you may be used to, this is Roses specific (you can sign in to both using the same app). You can switch between workspaces by clicking on the logo next to the Workspaces name in the top left hand corner of the app homepage. See Below for Examples:



I've been assigned as an assistant producer. What should I do?

Your job is to support the producer to make sure they have everything they need to make the stream work well. Speak to your producer to see what they're in need of, and how you should best work together. Importantly, on the day, when the producer needs a break as some streams are very long, you can take over. It might be best to have a plan about when this will happen!

I can no longer produce at Roses 2024.

If this is the case please alert your Production Lead immediately. We understand that things do come up, but please let us know as soon as you find out.
